## **2. TaRGeT License**

---

This section introduces the terms used in the license, the reasons for choosing the MIT license and the license itself.

### **2.1 About the MIT License**

TaRGeT is an open source software whose code and documentation are covered by the MIT license [1].

Before presenting the license, we define below the terminology used in this document:

- **Distributor:** the software development team that gives the rights to someone else.
- **Receptor:** the person or company that receives the rights to copy, modify and distribute the software.

The MIT license was chosen because it assures copyright for receptors to use TaRGeT and allows them to choose what kind of software (proprietary or free) they will develop based on the tool.

The MIT license defines terms and conditions for copying, distributing and modifying TaRGeT. However, its text is not copyrighted. Therefore, it can be modified to meet the needs of any project.

All derivative work made by receptors, such as modifications in the architecture or new features developed based on TaRGeT, must be available to the distributor. The derivative work can be copied and modified only for research purposes, and it will be distributed to other receptors only under the permission of the receptor that modified or developed the new features on the distributed TaRGeT code.

The complete license text is presented in the following section.

- The distributor must have access to all modifications and extensions made to the TaRGeT code and its documentation:

  - All software developed based on TaRGeT or using it can only be used for research purposes;
  - Distributor can make receptor's modifications publicly available only under the receptor's authorization.
